This scholarship is made possible by the generosity of the Wentcher Foundation, with the Oakton Community College Educational Foundation serving as its agent. Ten (10) annual scholarships, valued at up to \$3,500 per year each, are available for high school graduates enrolling full time (12 credit hours or more) at Oakton. Scholarships may be renewed for the following academic year based on sufficient funding and minimum grade point average. The scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, and required supplies.

Requirements:

- 3.0 unweighted grade point average
- U.S. citizen or FAFSA-eligible non-citizen (e.g. legal permanent resident)
- Printed copy of high school transcript
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or other professional
- Copy of 2022-2023 Student Aid Report (SAR) from the FAFSA (www.fafsa.gov)
- Completed scholarship application and essay
- Virtual interview with the Wentcher Foundation Scholarship Committee on Friday, April 22, 2022 (an appointment will be scheduled if you are selected to participate).

Not all applicants will be selected for an interview.

Applications will be considered based on academic merit, character, and financial need.
